



Recycled Material Sculpture Art Show Grades 5-12

Who? Any student from 5th to 12th grade is eligible to participate. This can be done as an individual or group. No limit on how many students can work on a sculpture.

What? Students are challenged to create large format sculpture artwork out of recyclable materials to make public art in a way that makes a statement about the environment. The sculpture should have an environmental/earth friendly theme. (please do not buy or create trash; please collect and clean existing trash)

Where? NVEF 2019 Earth Day Sculpture Show will be showcased Saturday, April 27, 2019 at Tenafly Middle School, Tenafly, NJ from 11am-4pm as part of our Earth Day Celebration!

When? All original sculptures must be delivered to the fair by the artist(s) on Saturday April 27, 2019 for display by 10AM. It must be picked up by 4PM when cleanup begins.

Rules?

1. All rules are created by the Northern Valley Earth Fair 2019 Art Committee.

2. Sculptures should be conceived as large outdoor pieces. This can mean that it consists of one large piece, several smaller pieces that are grouped together or many small pieces that are assembled as a field of items for a wider overall effect.
3. Sculptures must be transported to the site, Tenafly Middle School, Tenafly, NJ, on the day of the event and easily removed once the event is over. The artist(s) is responsible for the transportation, set up and removal of the piece on the day of the event. You will not be allowed to dispose of the sculpture on site.
4. Sculptures should be constructed of all or mostly all recyclable materials. If there is a need for a frame or if materials to connect things together aren't completely recyclable that is ok.
5. The theme can be supported by additional materials that the participant can choose to have on display alongside the sculpture. These can include but are not limited to sketches,
6. Ideas of Materials for Recycled Sculpture Project (Feel free to come up with your own)
 - bottles/cans/bottle caps
 - styrofoam
 - wire
 - CDs
 - plastic bags
 - chicken wire
 - bubble wrap
 - old clothes/rags
 - cardboard
 - gum wrappers
 - PVC tubes
7. The participant should create a title for the piece and display a sign on site with the title of the piece, the name of the artist(s), town name, and the theme.
